## Volunteer Opportunities

- ❑ **Annual Giving Committee:** responsible for securing unrestricted funding for the Annual Appeal. Successfully obtaining new donors while retaining and upgrading current donors. Parent volunteer callers are needed for our Annual Phone-a-thon.
- ❑ **Alumni Relations:** responsible for the recruitment and monitoring of Class Captains for the purposes of data management, communication, reunion organization, sharing of news, alumni attendance at events, and alumni recognition.
- ❑ **Special Events:** each special event is responsible for meeting the individual deadlines set forth by the chairman working with the Development Director.
  - **Cub's** is an annual event recognizing four alumni: two for the Alumni Hall of Distinction and two others for the Athletic Hall of Fame. Volunteer alumni are asked to volunteer to coordinate the event.
  - **Gerald Furr Classic** is an annual golf tournament held in honor of retired basketball Coach Gerald Furr and benefits U-High Athletics. Grandparents, Alumni and Parents are encouraged to assist by recruiting players, sponsors and auction items.
  - **Grandparents and Grand Friends Day** is an annual event held to invite grandparents and friends to the University Laboratory School to see their grandchildren in their school environment and visit and meet student faculty and administration. Parents are encouraged to help with the planning and day of event activities.
  - **Alumni Homecoming Tailgate Event** is an annual event held to reunite alumni during U-High's Homecoming. The event provides a complimentary dinner and children's entertainment prior to kick-off. Volunteer alumni are asked to volunteer to coordinate the event.
  - **The U-Club** was established to carry on the University High School's tradition of athletic excellence. The U-High Athletic Department is committed to securing support for its athletic programs and enriching the experience of student-athletes. Parents are needed to help solicit memberships and to assist with the day to day operations of the program.
  - **Cub Rock and Roar** is currently in the planning stages. This fundraiser will host a live band, silent auction, heavy hors d'oeuvres, and cash bar. Parents are needed to help sell tickets, obtain sponsors, auction items and for overall planning.
